

## THE ONE-DAY WASTE WALK GUIDE

A practical guide to help your team spot and eliminate costly inefficiencies fast. Use it to conduct a focused 30–60 minute waste walk that reveals hidden sources of waste across your operation.

# Step-by-Step Walkthrough

### 1 - Prep the Team

- Define the process/area (e.g., Packaging Line, Station B)
- Assign roles: Facilitator, Scribe, Observers
- Print Waste Observation Form + Checklist
- Review process maps and objectives
- Ensure PPE compliance

### 2 - Walk with Purpose

- Follow the flow-from raw materials to output
- Watch for: idle machines, unnecessary movement, overprocessing
- Ask operators: "What slows you down?" "Why is this step needed?"

#### 3 - Document What You See

- Use the form to capture:
- Type of waste
- Specific observation
- Location
- Possible solution
- Priority level

#### 4 - Debrief and Act

- Review as a team-prioritize high-impact issues
- Assign owners and timelines
- Set short-term targets (e.g., reduce motion waste by 25%)

#### **Pro Tip**

Don't fix things during the walk, just observe, listen, and record. Solutions come after the walk.

## The Top 8 Wastes to Watch For

Waste	Clue	
Overproduction	Extra units, unneeded rework	
Waiting	Idle machines or people	
Transport	Moving materials without value	
Overprocessing	Redundant steps	
Inventory	Excess parts or WIP	
Motion	Extra walking, reaching, searching	
Defects	efects Rework, scrap, inspection fails
